Arrival/Dismissal & Lunch Reminders

Please be reminded that school yard supervision does not start until 8:45 a.m. Please do not drop off your child(ren) in the schoolyard yard before this time. Dismissal is at 3:30 p.m. Students will be dismissed through the doors to the school yard. Please arrange for prompt pick-up of your child(ren) at the end of the day. Parents/Guardians are reminded to not crowd doors to ensure safe dismissal procedures.

Please be reminded that we do not have a lunch table this year. Students should come to school with a lunch packed for the day. Where this is not possible, parents/guardians will be required to drop lunch during the school lunch hour only and wait until their child is called from class. Please note that third-party food delivery services (i.e., Uber Eats, Door Dash, etc.) are not permitted for security reasons.
